BELLE GLADE REGISTERED VOTERS



The City of Belle Glade's March 13, 2018 Election, to fill three City Commission Seats, is soon approaching. Only those qualified registered voters living within the corporate limits of the City of Belle Glade, who are registered in Precincts 6022, 6024, 6028, 6029, 6032, or 6036, may vote in this election.

If you are not able to go to the polls on election day to cast your ballot, you may obtain an absentee ballot at the Palm Beach County's Glades Office Building located on the 2nd Floor at 2976 State Road 15 (corner of North Main and State Road 80) in Belle Glade, or you, or someone designated by the voter, may request an absentee ballot from the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections office, in person, by mail, on-line at www.pbcelections.org, or by calling (toll free) 1-866-868-3321. Remember to bring current and valid picture and signature identification, such as a driver's license, or some form of photo identification bearing your photo and signature. If you do not have a photo/signature ID, you will be required to vote a provisional ballot.
